PSU-Asingan Launches "3-Wheeled Classroom" to Empower Out-of-School Youths

Pangasinan State University-Asingan Campus (PSU-AC), in partnership with DepEd and Asingan LGUs, launched an innovative "3-Wheeled Classroom" project on December 1, 2023 at Teofilo Gante Elementary School, aimed at equipping Out-of-School Youths (OSYs) with essential literacy, numeracy, and computer skills. Dr. Madlyn D. Tingco, Campus Executive Director, encouraged participants to seize this opportunity to shape their future, while project leaders Dr. Mary Jane U. Quibilan and Dr. Elsa Q. Terre emphasized education's transformative power. Municipal representatives and dedicated faculty, including Prof. Adoracion Gante and teacher-facilitators, played key roles in supporting the project's success. 
